

Recipe for a Classroom Basket:

1. Please try to only include items in the basket that are actually donated. . Please refrain from requesting donations from the businesses in the marketplace. They are already big donors for the PTIC and we do not want to inundate them with more donation requests.
2. Should your basket include alcohol please do not bring the baskets to the school for drop off.
3. Typically baskets sell for less than half of their actual value. We encourage you to keep the value of your basket at less than \$400. If parents choose to give you cash/checks instead of items for the basket, giving cash/checks directly to the PTIC as a donation, instead of going out to purchase items for the basket, will make that money go further. **Any basket valued at more than \$400 may be divided into another basket or may be placed in the live auction.**
4. We will need a full break down for the contents of the basket. An itemized list with prices and a total value when it is turned in on or before April 11th. We must be sure to have an accurate value and breakdown of items in the baskets for tax purposes.
5. Ensure that all items in the basket are clearly visible and/or well described.
6. Deadline for completed baskets is April 11, 2016.
7. Basket drop off will be on April 4th from 4:30-7:30. Please contact Jennifer Barron with any questions. jennifer.k.barron@gmail.com
